

ERC Advanced Grant (ERC-AdG) Call 2015

On the 10th of February 2015, a call to submit proposals under the "ERC Advanced Grant 2015" was opened.

About the ERC Advanced Grants

ERC Programme aims at providing attractive, long-term funding to support excellent investigators and their research teams to pursue ground-breaking, high-gain/ high-risk research, leading to advances at the frontiers of knowledge. In specific, ERC Advanced Grants are designed to support **excellent Principal Investigators (PIs)** at the career stage at which they are already established research leaders. PIs must demonstrate the **ground-breaking nature, ambition and feasibility of their scientific proposal**.

Applications may be made in any field of research. Special emphasis is given to frontier research: proposals of an interdisciplinary nature, pioneering proposals addressing new and emerging fields of research or proposals introducing unconventional, innovative approaches and scientific inventions are encouraged.

Who can participate?

Active researchers, of any age and any nationality, with a track record of significant research achievements **in the last 10 years**.

What is the value of the grant?

Advanced Grants can be awarded up to a maximum of **EUR 2.500.000,00** for a period of 5 years (pro rata for projects of shorter duration).

However, up to an additional EUR 1.000.000,00 can be requested in the proposal to cover: eligible "start-up" costs and/or the purchase of major equipment and/or access to large facilities.
